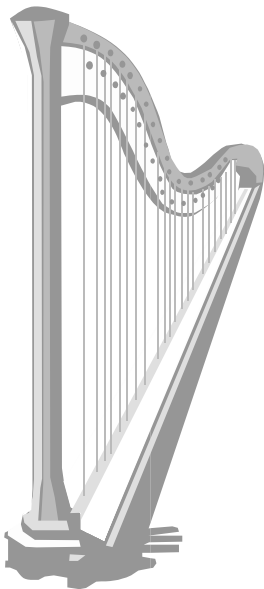
The process of creating this songbook included research with current copyright holders and artists. The lyrics and melodies — while they might not match other songbooks — are the result of that collaboration.

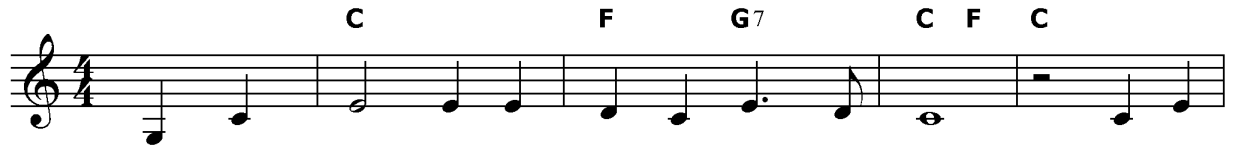

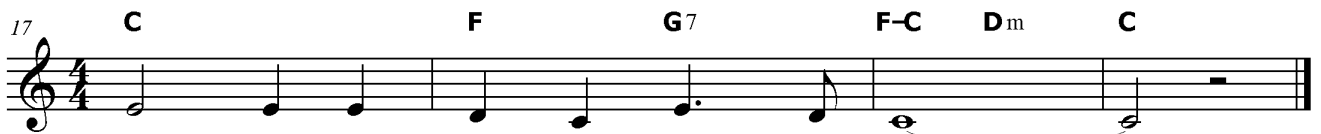
